**A RUN FOR THE TITLE HAS GRIST FOCUSED IN 2015**

**Indianapolis, IN** - Garrett Grist, driver of the #5 Lander Property Management, Juncos Racing entry in the Pro Mazda Championship Presented by Cooper Tires is focused on one goal; winning. The move from Andretti Autosport to Juncos Racing puts GG in the perfect position to take on what will be a tough field again in 2015.

Strong showings in his rookie season of Pro Mazda action has Garrett very excited to hit the track at this weekend's Firestone Grand Prix of St. Petersburg. The golf coast city will again host the start of not only the IndyCar season but all three levels of the Mazda Road to Indy. This will be Garrett's third trip to the tricky street course that winds through the streets of the popular Florida destination.



"I'm excited to get the season started in St. Pete this coming week," comments GG. "I've enjoyed working with my new team and they have been teaching me a lot. The off-season program has been pretty intense. We hit the track for two days of testing last week to make final preparations for the season."

For Garrett and the #5 Lander Property Management entry, the 2015 Pro Mazda Championship Presented by Cooper Tires begins March 28-29 with two rounds in St. Petersburg, Florida. Over the course of the year the talented teen will race 16 rounds over nine different weekends.



During the off-season Garrett was able to put together a new social media marketing program that includes a partnership with BlackList. Garrett and his commercial partners will be featured on BlackList on a regular basis.

In 2012 Garrett raced in the F1600 Championship with Bryan Herta Autosports. For 2013, he joined Andretti Autosport for the Cooper Tires USF2000 Championship powered by Mazda, winning three races. In 2014, Garrett moved up to the Pro Mazda Championship Presented by Cooper Tires with Andretti Autosport where he earned two wins and four poles. For 2015, GG has moved to the 2014 Pro Mazda Champions - Juncos Racing.
