GRIST SQUARELY FOCUSED ON MID-OHIO

"Focused on putting the difficult Iowa Speedway event behind him, Garrett looks to keep winning streak alive at the Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course."



Indianapolis, IN - Garrett Grist, driver of the #5 Lander Property Management, Juncos Racing entry endured a difficult run at Iowa Speedway. Grist was quickest in the first session and third quick in the second session. Grist would roll off eighth in single car qualifying and put his Juncos Racing Pro Mazda on Pole with an average speed of 144MPH around the 7/8 mile oval.

That Pole position would be short lived as all the Juncos Racing cars were disqualified from

qualifying due to a procedural infraction on the qualifying grid. This would demote GG to the 12th starting position for the evening race. Garrett would push as best he could from deep in the field but had to settle for 11th place as the checkered flag flew on the 100-lap feature race.



"Iowa was a tough one for the whole team," states Grist. "We had a good car and things didn't go our way. We win as a team and we lose as a team. That race is now behind us. I'm looking forward to Mid-Ohio this weekend. It's a track where I've always had success. Every year that I've been in the Road to Indy, I have won there. At the official test a couple weeks ago, I was quickest both days. We plan to carry that momentum into this weekend."

For Garrett and the #5 Lander Property Management entry, the 2015 Pro Mazda Championship Presented by Cooper Tires field hit the 2.25 mile 13 turn road course on Thursday for three sessions of testing. That is followed by practice and qualifying on Friday, July 31st. Saturday, August 1st and Sunday, August 2nd, will see one round of racing each day to complete the double-header weekend.

ABOUT GARETT:

Garrett began his car racing program in 2011 with a highly successful debut in Canadian Formula Ford action taking several wins, poles and fast laps. In 2012 Garrett raced in the F1600 Championship with Bryan Herta Autosports. For 2013, he joined Andretti Autosport for the Cooper Tires USF2000 Championship powered by Mazda, winning three races. In 2014, Garrett moved up to the Pro Mazda Championship Presented by Cooper Tires with Andretti Autosport where he earned two wins and four poles. For 2015, GG has moved to the 2014 Pro Mazda Champions- Juncos Racing.
